Local Fire Code Briefing Form

After completing the online 14 CFR 139.321 portion of the ACE, Inc. Fuel Safety Supervisor Training, the line supervisor/manager must also recieve a fire code briefing on local fire regulations to be conducted by the local Authority Having Jurisdiction. This information MUST be conveyed to the students of the supervisor.
